

**Winterville Citizens Advisory Committee**  
**Minutes for April 30, 2019**

The Winterville Citizens Advisory Committee held a meeting on April 30, 2019 at the Winterville Depot in Winterville, Georgia. Present and participating at the meeting were Mike Shockley, Jonathan Scott, Sam Alvarez, Bob Bonsall, Brian Binder, Bruce Johnson and Shauna Smith.

Chairman Shockley called the meeting to order. On motion duly made and properly seconded, the minutes of the meeting of the Winterville Citizens Advisory Committee held on April 23, 2019, as previously distributed to the committee members, were approved.

After some brief comments, Chairman Shockley recognized Wendy Bond, City Clerk, who discussed with the committee needs of the City Clerk's Office in order to provide for the citizens of Winterville. Mrs. Bond will submit her requests in writing in order of priority to Chairman Shockley.

Chairman Shockley then recognized Joann Snow, Winterville Community Center Director, for a discussion of improvements/needs of the Winterville Community Center. Chairman Shockley requested Mrs. Snow submit her requests in writing for the committee to review.

Chairman Shockley then called upon Winterville Fire Department Chief Michael Gabriel. Chief Gabriel provided each committee member with a list of items that the Fire Department needs to continue serving the City of Winterville adequately. After discussion with Chief Gabriel, it was determined that he would add additional items to his proposal and re-submit it to the committee in order of priority.

Chairman Shockley then recognized Winterville Police Assistant Chief Wayne Gabriel. Assistant Chief Gabriel was attending the meeting on behalf of Chief Finley who could not attend due to a family emergency. Assistant Chief Gabriel provided the committee with a list of needs for the Winterville Police Department.

After Assistant Chief Gabriel concluded his presentation to, and discussion with, the committee, Chairman Shockley recognized Winterville City Arborist Roger Cauthen. Mr. Cauthen discussed with the committee various projects relating to landscaping needs around the City of Winterville and, in particular, along and around the future Firefly Trail that will be constructed through the City of Winterville.

Chairman Shockley agreed to contact Tom Doonan, Director of Public Works, and David Matthews-Morgan, who will represent the Winterville Arts Council/Auditorium for possible presentations at the next committee meeting.

In addition to the above presentations, the committee discussed again the need to obtain input from the Citizens of Winterville regarding possible SPLOST projects. Chairman Shockley will inquire as to the status of the City webpage and e-mail address for submissions from the general

public. Mr. Johnson expressed his concern over the lack of notice to the public of the ongoing meetings. The committee may need to solicit input from Mayor Ferrelle and the City Attorney regarding this issue.

It was determined that the next meeting would be held on Tuesday, May 7, 2019 at the Winterville Depot in Winterville, Georgia.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:25 p.m.
