The City of Winterville has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 4.35 percent. All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall on Tuesday July 3, 2018 at 5:00 pm.

Public Hearing #2 – 5:30 pm

The City of Winterville, acting by and through the Mayor and City Council of Winterville, desires to hold public hearings to consider the enactment of an ordinance that amends the Charter of the City of Winterville pursuant to its authority conferred by the Constitution and the Laws of Georgia. The proposed amendment would remove the Charter's restrictions that prevent the Mayor and City Council from granting licenses to sell spirituous, vinous, malt or other intoxicating liquors within the City of Winterville, and authorize the Mayor and City Council to issue licenses or permits for the sale or manufacture of distilled spirits, malt beverages or wine within the City of Winterville in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia and any rules, regulations and ordinances enacted by the City of Winterville.

The Mayor and City Council shall hold the second of two public hearings to receive public input on the proposed amendment on July 3, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. at the Winterville City Hall at 125 N. The Mayor and City Council intend to hold additional public hearings and to consider an ordinance to amend the Charter of the City of Winterville at the Mayor and City Council's regular scheduled meetings on July 10, 2018 and on August 14, 2018 both of which will be held at Winterville City Hall, 125 N. Church Street, Winterville, Georgia 30683 at 6:30 P.M.
