Public Hearing 5:00 pm

The Mayor and Council of the City of Winterville met at Winterville City Hall for a Public Hearing.

The City of Winterville tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 6.54 percent. All concerned citizens were invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall on Tuesday July 2, 2019 at 5:00 pm. All interested parties wishing to address the Mayor and City Council must sign up to speak in advance of the hearing.

Mayor Ferrelle opened the Public Hearing at 5:00 pm. Also present were Councilpersons Mary Quinn, Brenda Keen, Gary Snow and Municipal City Clerk Wendy Bond.

Mayor Ferrelle gave a verbal summary of the reason for the increase due to the amount of new construction and re-evaluations of property values.
